March 26, 1:00 - 3:00pm: Wonderful Waterfowl

The arrival of spring also brings the return of many of Alberta's waterfowl species. Join us for a discussion on where these waterfowl species are coming from, what draws them to Alberta, and what you can do to help waterfowl in the wild.

May 28, 1:00 - 3:00pm: Baby Boom

The busiest season for AIWC can be boiled down to two words: baby boom. During this month's talk, we will introduce you to the different kinds of wildlife babies in care, discuss the methods we use to raise them, and what you can do to help wildlife babies in your own backyard.

July 30, 1:00 - 3:00pm: Fact or Fiction?

Are bats actually blind? Do owls only hunt at night? Will a skunk spray immediately? Learn the truth behind these and other animal myths during AIWC's July event.

September 24, 1:00 - 3:00pm: Beautiful Bats

Did you know that Alberta has not one, not two, but nine species of bats that call this province home? Join us for a one-hour presentation on Alberta's bat residents, including where they live, how they survive, and what you can do to help bats in your area.

November 5, 1:00 - 3:00pm: Sweet Slumber

November's session focuses on the many different species of wildlife that choose to sleep through the winter. We will discuss which animals can hibernate, how they actually stay alive during hibernation, and what you can do to ensure that hibernating wildlife in your area remain asleep and undisturbed.

Each talk will be followed by a guided tour of AIWC's facilities and the opportunity to view some of the patients currently in care.
