## MAKE YOUR OWN TOOTHPASTE

### **Ingredients:**

1 tsp fine sea salt

3 tsp baking soda

1/4 cup organic coconut oil

5 drops of peppermint essential oil (optional)

### **Directions:**

- 1. Combine salt and baking soda in a glass jar
- 2. Melt the coconut oil and add to dry ingredients. Stir with a fork to combine.
- 3. Store in a cool, dark place for up to 3 weeks.

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## MAKE YOUR OWN ALL-PURPOSE SURFACE CLEANER

### **Ingredients:**

2 cups of citrus peels (lemon or orange)

2 cups distilled whilte vinegar

Water

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Fill a jar with your choice of citrus peels and pour vinegar over top.
- 2. Seal jar tight and let sit for 1 week.
- 3. Stain out the peels and place them in the compost.
- 4. Fill a spray bottle halfway with the citrus infused vinegar and fill the other half with water.
- 5. Time to clean!
